Riwaka (85.6-23) is a triploid aroma type bred during the development of New Zealand Hops with a Difference programme through crossing Old Line Saazer with specially developed New Zealand breeding selections. It was first released by New Zealand's Plant & Food Research in 1997.

Brewing

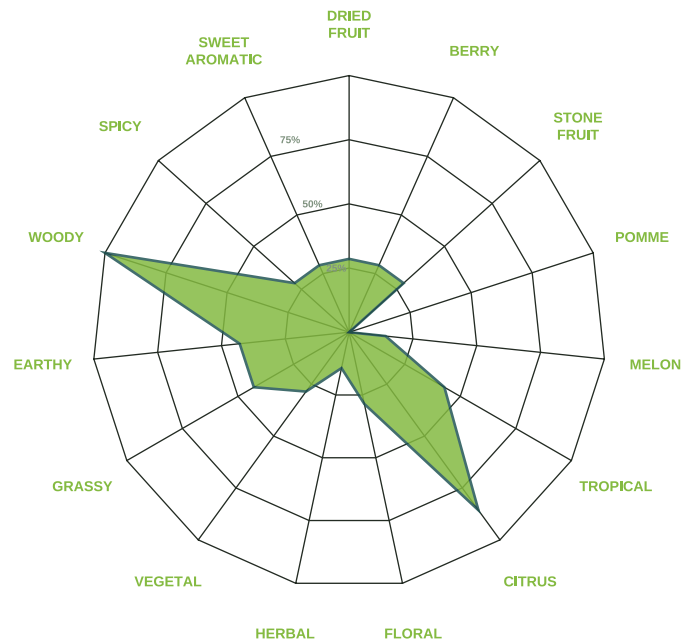
